SUMMER READING LOG – Required for *all* students enrolled for the 2017-2018 school year

All students attending EAS for the 2017-2018 school year are expected to maintain a summer reading log that will be due during the first week of school in September. 6th and 7th grade students currently enrolled at EAS (i.e., next year’s 7th and 8th graders) will be receiving a copy of the Summer Reading Log before summer break. Parents of incoming 6th graders, we are relying on you to print a copy of this log for your child and go over the reading expectations with him/her. Likewise, any current EAS student who is absent when the logs are distributed later this week are expected to print and maintain the log for themselves. All students are expected to read a minimum of 800 pages at an appropriate level of challenge/grade level during the summer and record their books in the section titled “Independent Reading Record” on the log.
