

What is Scrip?

Scrip fundraising is a no-selling program that enables families to raise money for EAS school fees. Think of Scrip as another way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards (physical or eCards via email) in place of cash, checks, and credit cards.

You purchase gift cards from your organization at face value, and your coordinator orders those cards from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a reduced price. The difference is an instant rebate for your family. It's really that simple!

Great Lakes Scrip Center offers more than 700 of the country's biggest retailers, including grocery, department stores, gas stations, restaurants, hotels, home improvement, and more. Just by using scrip to pay for your normal weekly purchases, you can easily raise \$500 or more per year. It's time to put your shopping dollars to work!

Setting up your SCRIP account:

1. Families participating in the EAS Scrip Program must:

- a. Fill out the Family Scrip Agreement
- b. The Family Scrip Agreement can be found on the EAS School website under the Students/Families tab on the Scrip Program page: <https://eas.lwsd.org/studentsfamilies/scrip-program>
- c. Once the form is filled out, you can scan & email them to the scrip coordinator (scrip@easpto.org) or drop it off at the EAS office to the attention of the Scrip Coordinator

2. Shop with Scrip: Account Set Up

Go to <http://www.shopwithscrip.com>

- a. Click on the blue rounded rectangle "Join a Program" located at the top right
- b. Enter the EAS enrollment code; **684ADBDE15871** and click **Register** (this number may change, see the EAS Scrip Program page for the most updated information)
- c. Create your user name choosing something you will easily remember (i.e. email address), enter password and your account information
- d. EAS PTO will not accept any "paper" orders (i.e. check or money order). Any such orders will be deleted by the Scrip Coordinator. All orders are processed through PrestoPay.
- e. Once your account is set up, you will have to log back in and set up your online payment option through PrestoPay.

3. Presto Pay: Set Up

- a. Follow the steps to enroll by either instantly linking your bank account or entering banking information manually
- b. Click on the Payment Types link under Family Functions on your Dashboard. Choose whether you want to instantly link your bank account or manually enter your banking information and follow the steps for each.
- c. Manually entering your information will take 1-2 business days to process
- d. You'll be ready to pay for your order with Online Payments (PrestoPay)
- e. Please note that a small \$0.15 convenience fee will apply to each order. Currently, you can't link a credit card to your Online Payments (PrestoPay) account, as the credit card fees would take away from your rebate earnings.
