- Nylon pants and jackets are NOT adequate raingear. Raingear must be WATERPROOF. Even items that were waterproof when new can lose their repellant quality! All raingear must be tested for waterproof quality before going on expedition if fabric soaks when sprayed with water, consider treating with water repellant spray (available at REI or sports stores) to ensure that fabric is waterproof. This treatment usually requires 72 hours to cure so don't delay, check today!!
