Snow Sports Registration

Hello Snow Sports Enthusiasts! The time is now... Registration for the Snow Program is open!

Next, please bring \$150 payment by check (with student name and "SNOW" in the memo), securely attach it to the 2019 Snow Waiver and submit them to the Snow Sports Basket in the EAS office. Snow Waivers can be printed here: [EAS Snow Program Waiver 2019](#)

***Note:** If you have already submitted your waiver and payment (thank you!), please make sure to fill out the online registration for the bus above.

After bus registration, payment and waiver are received, you will get a confirmation email indicating the instructions for purchasing discounted Stevens Season Passes and Lessons. (Lessons are required for beginners and strongly recommended for everyone else).

Please note \$150 is the cost of the bus only. \$150 is subject to change based on the number of participants and will not exceed \$200. In addition to the bus registration, students will need to purchase a season pass, lessons and acquire snow sports gear.

Deadline for registration is Friday, November 30, 2018 or when the charter bus is sold out, whichever comes first.
