### **KNITTING - FEE \$35**

### **POTTERY/COMIC ART – FEE \$150**

Join artists at Redmond Art Works for this fun pottery and comic art class. Students will spend 4 weeks learning the fundamentals of pottery and 2 weeks learning the art of comic creations. Students will have the opportunity to work on a potter's wheel, sculpt, and glaze while creating 4-7 pieces to take home. In the 2 weeks of comic art will Learn the fundamentals of sequential storytelling from a master artist through panel layout, basic penciling, and inking skills and using basic color to enhance storytelling. ### **NINJA TRAINING AT NORTHWEST AERIALS – Fee \$45**

Ninja training combines gymnastics, trampoline, parkour & martial arts into one class. You will train like a ninja on the obstacle course, climbing wall, peg wall, rope swing, rope climb, cargo net, salmon ladder and more!

This class will include water safety, practicing lap swim/swim team etiquette, building endurance, fitness drills and water games. This is a great opportunity for some fun and engaging water conditioning as a complement to any sport or just to have great fun!! ### **3D ART AND ANIMATION - Fee \$110**

If you are interested in 3D art & animations, this could be the course for you! You will learn how to create a character and make it into a 3D model and animate it using Blender. You will also learn how to make it move using Unity. This course is designed for those of you who are absolute beginners to Blender/Unity and interested in creating 3D animations. Class taught by Kunitake Aoki, from STEAMforTeens and an industry veteran who has worked on various titles such as the Sonic series and the Mario vs. Donkey Kong series at Sega and Nintendo for over 28 years. Class taught on site. NO CARPOOLS REQUIRED but PARENT HELPERS APPRECIATED.

### **MAGIC THE GATHERING & BOARD GAMES - FEE \$36**

The MAGIC craze continues. This class will give you the option of playing a variety of board games and/or challenging other in Magic the Gathering.
