Session 4 elective dates:

February 20, 27 March 6, 13, 20 & 27

LEARN TO COOK ITALIAN AND GREEK- FEE \$70

Have you ever wanted to learn how to make amazing Greek and Italian dishes? Come join EAS parents, Kristi Mallios and Silvia Bajardi in their kitchens as you create dishes like Pastitsio, Pasta al forno and more. At the end of each class you will get to enjoy the warm meal you prepared. Opa! Dishes will include gluten, no nuts. Class limited to 12 students. RETURN CARPOOL DRIVERS NEEDED, Parent instructors Kristi and Silvia can provide transportation to location.

BLACKSMITHING AT PRATT FINE ARTS CENTER – FEE \$160

This elective is a great opportunity to learn blacksmithing. Blacksmithing, or forging, is about transforming and shaping cold hard steel through the use of heat. Using basic techniques such as hammering, twisting, tapers, bends, and splits, students will have the opportunity to create sculptural and functional objects. Class size limited to 8 students. Class takes place at Pratt Fine Arts Center in Seattle. All materials are included. ** NOTE: STUDENTS MUST BE 12 OR 13 YEARS OF AGE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS ELECTIVE. PARENTS ARE REQUIRED TO DRIVE AT LEAST ONCE AND MUST INDICATE AVAILABILITY WHEN REGISTERING. (This is a 5 week session, no class on 3/27)

VERTICAL WORLD BEGINNING ROCK CLIMBING/QUIET STUDY– FEE \$66

Join Vertical World instructors to learn the basics of rock climbing in a safe environment. Students learn gym rules/safety, harness use, how to tie themselves in and how to belay and climb. After you learn the basics this session, you will be ready for the 7 week session in April. This is also a great option for those wanting some extra study time, as 2 weeks will be spent in quiet study at EAS.

POTTERY/MIXED MEDIA ART - FEE \$150

Join artists at Redmond Art Works for this fun pottery and mixed media art class. Students will spend 4 weeks learning the fundamentals of pottery and 2 weeks doing a mixed media self portrait. Students will have the opportunity to work on a potter's wheel, sculpt, and glaze while creating 4-7 pieces to take home. No art experience needed. All materials included in the class fee. DUNGEON & DRAGONS- NO FEE

Come join 8th grade students, Jasper Fries and Quinn Fitzpatrick for Dugneon and Dragons. Dungeons and Dragons is a table top cooperative roleplaying game where you and your friends create characters and go on adventures together. Whether you have never heard of D&D before, have been wanting to play, or have been playing for years, this is the elective for you! NO CARPOOLS REQUIRED BUT CLASS CHAPERONE NEEDED

SPORTS SAMPLER - FEE \$54

Join the enthusiastic coaches at Arena Sports in Redmond for a great time sampling different sports. Students will get to play a variety of sports during the 6 week session. Games will include dodgeball, soccer, capture the flag, ultimate frisbee, kickball,

field hockey and/or lacrosse as well., including field hockey, capture the flag, and kickball. Each sport is meant to be fun and encourage team work. No experience is necessary but good sportsmanship is required. These will be no contact sports and overly aggressive play by students will not allowed. Class runs from 11-12:15. DANCE MIX WITH AMANDA - FEE \$60

You suggested it and here it is. Amanda White, a favorite EAS Alum and dance instructor will bring the energy and fun for this dance mix elective. Join her for hip hop and jazz as well as other suggestions you might have. Class taught on site. NO CARPOOLS REQUIRED.

CAKE DECORATING - FEE \$105

Join Dawn of Dawn's Cake and Candy to learn the amazing art of cake decorating and frosting. This class will explore fondant, basic piping and frosting techniques and much more. Students signing up should be serious about learning the art of cake decorating, not just have a love for eating cake. CARPOOLS REQUIRED. ** NOTE: PARENTS ARE REQUIRED TO DRIVE AT LEAST ONCE AND MUST INDICATE AVAILABILITY WHEN REGISTERING.

YEARBOOK- NO FEE

Students will learn how to plan and execute a long term creative project. Our current EAS parent yearbook advisor along with our student editors will help guide students to develop the 2016-2017 book—from selecting photos (contributed by digital photography students, parents and teachers) and developing page themes to actually creating the final yearbook. Class will meet from 10:30 to 12:30 and all work on the yearbook will be done in-class during this elective. Join the yearbook team and help to create the best yearbook ever!

NINJA/TRAMPOLINE - FEE \$45

In this part ninja, part trampoline class you will have the opportunity to experience two elective favorites. You will learn trampoline basics, movement and exercises. Then you can train like a ninja on the obstacle course, climbing wall, peg wall, rope climb, salmon ladder and more! Students will spend the first 30 minutes in quiet study at EAS. CIRCUS ARTS - FEE \$130*

Have you ever thought about joining the circus? Wanna' know what it takes to be part of the show? This introductory class features a variety of the physical and mental disciplines involved in the circus arts - think juggling, acrobatics, tumbling, tight rope and more. It is 9 hours of circus fun for any skill level and an excellent opportunity to test your limits. Class taught at Studio East in Kirkland by Nathan Drackett, professional circus arts teacher/trainer.
